What is the psychosocial impact of assistive devices scale – plain language version?

The psychosocial impact of assistive devices scale – plain language version, is a survey with 19 questions. You are asked to answer questions about assistive technology you are using, such as if it makes:

- it easier for you to do things
- you feel safe
- you feel happy.

For questions 1 to 15, you are asked to circle the face that matches how you feel when you use your technology:



Never



Almost Never



Sometimes



Almost Always



Always

For questions 16 to 19 you are asked to put a tick in the box for the answer that is true for you.

Your answers to these questions can help you see what:

- is working well
- needs to be better.

How long will it take to answer all the questions?

It will take you around 5 to 10 minutes to answer all the questions on the psychosocial impact of assistive devices scale – plain language version.
