

# Assistive Technology Usability Questionnaire for people with Neurological diseases

## What information will I gain from the Assistive Technology Usability Questionnaire for people with Neurological diseases?

The Assistive Technology Usability Questionnaire for people with Neurological diseases (NATU Quest) includes 10-items to measure the level of acceptance and satisfaction with assistive technology. Each item is rated from 0 (strongly disagree) to 5 (strongly agree), and for accessibility the response options include traffic light colouring of the numbers and faces with expressions.

## How long does it take to administer the measure?

The NATU Quest takes around 5 minutes to complete. Depending on the support needs of the person, the NATU Quest can be completed independently by the person, or it can be completed with the person as an interview or conversation.

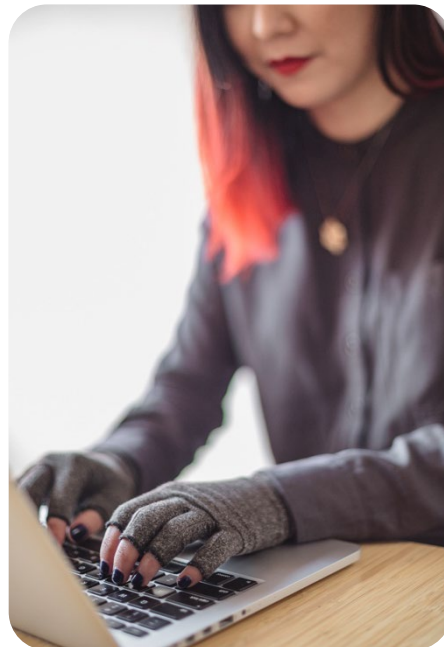
## How do I report or score the measure?

A total score is calculated by adding the scores across the 10-items and dividing by the sum of number of valid items. Total scores can range from 0 to 5. A score from 0 to 2 is a negative result, and a score from 3 to 5 a positive result.
