

# The Community Integration Questionnaire-Revised

## What information will I gain from the Community Integration Questionnaire-Revised?

The Community Integration Questionnaire - Revised (CIQ-R) is an 18-item rating scale that measures integration across four subscales: active participation of the person in the running of the home (home integration); participation in a variety of activities outside the home and interpersonal relations (social integration); involvement in employment, education and volunteer activities (productivity); and participation in electronic social networking (electronic social networking).<sup>1</sup> This information can support goal setting with the person.

## How do I administer, report, or score the assessment?

The CIQ-R takes around 10-15 minutes to administer. The CIQ-R can be completed by a person who knows the individual with ABI well. Additionally, it can be completed in an interview style with the person with ABI, although this is not advised if the person experiences significant cognitive impairment which may affect responses. There is a detailed manual available to guide administration.<sup>2</sup>

The CIQ-R rating form is used to record the level or frequency of involvement in a range of community activities including financial management, grocery shopping, child-care, meal preparation, housework, community access, social activities, employment, study, and volunteer work, along with the use of technology-enabled interactions. Scores are primarily created by report of performance frequency, with additional weight given on whether assistance is required.
